HSC & IB PUBLIC EXAMINATION RESULTS

Congratulations to Vivek Srinivasan who attained an IB Score of 45 and an ATAR of 99.95 = 1st in the World and Top of the State

13 Students of the Class of 2011 received an ATAR over 99 equal to the Top 1% of the State

21 Students gained either a HSC All Round Achievers Award or an International Baccalaureate Distinction Certificate.

Overall ATARs achieved by the Class of 2011

- 22.6% achieved an ATAR at or above 95
- 38.2% achieved an ATAR at or above 90
- 52.2% achieved an ATAR at or above 85
- 62.9% achieved an ATAR at or above 80

Congratulations to our boys, their parents and dedicated staff for rounding off 2011 as such a remarkable year of all-round excellence. A year that witnessed stellar achievements: in the pool, on the basketball courts, on the sporting fields, as well as the stage and now, most importantly, in the classroom. Well done, Class of 2011!

HIGHER SCHOOL CERTIFICATE 2011

The Class of 2011 confirms that we can be well pleased with the fine performance of our seniors who undertook the HSC option as their pre-tertiary qualification. Well done, Class of 2011 HSC Students and Staff.

Our HSC results are most positive and the following highlights detailed by the Director of Studies are worth noting:

Once again, the Trinity community can be well pleased with the results earned in the HSC examinations by our outgoing Year 12 students. No doubt many boys will be celebrating with their families as they reap the reward for countless hours of hard work, not just in Year 12, but throughout their years at Trinity.

One highlight of the HSC results is the great strength shown by boys of average academic ability, whose hard work has won them a place in Band 5 and 6. 51% of Trinity results were in the top two Bands. Even without the IB students (some 52 boys whose ATAR average was in excess of 95) this would be a wonderful result for any completely non-selective school.

In Extension subjects, 35% of results were in the top Band, and a whopping 79% in the top two Bands.

*One Trinity boy, **Naeman Goetz**, achieved the extraordinary honour of being named First in the State in German Continuers. Naeman actually achieved this wonderful accolade as an accelerant, and will complete his HSC programme in 2012. **Mark Azer**, another accelerant – but with a difference: he will complete his HSC in 2013! – achieved 14th place in the State in Mathematics and 6th in Mathematics Extension 1!*

Four boys have qualified as HSC All-Rounders, recognising candidates who achieve in the highest Band in at least ten units of study. The boys who have qualified for this honour are:

- **Matthew Jackson**
- **Edwin Lau**
- **Jack Ryan**

Congratulations to these boys on an outstanding achievement. What does not appear publicly is that four of them walked it in with 11 or 12 top band results.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE 2011

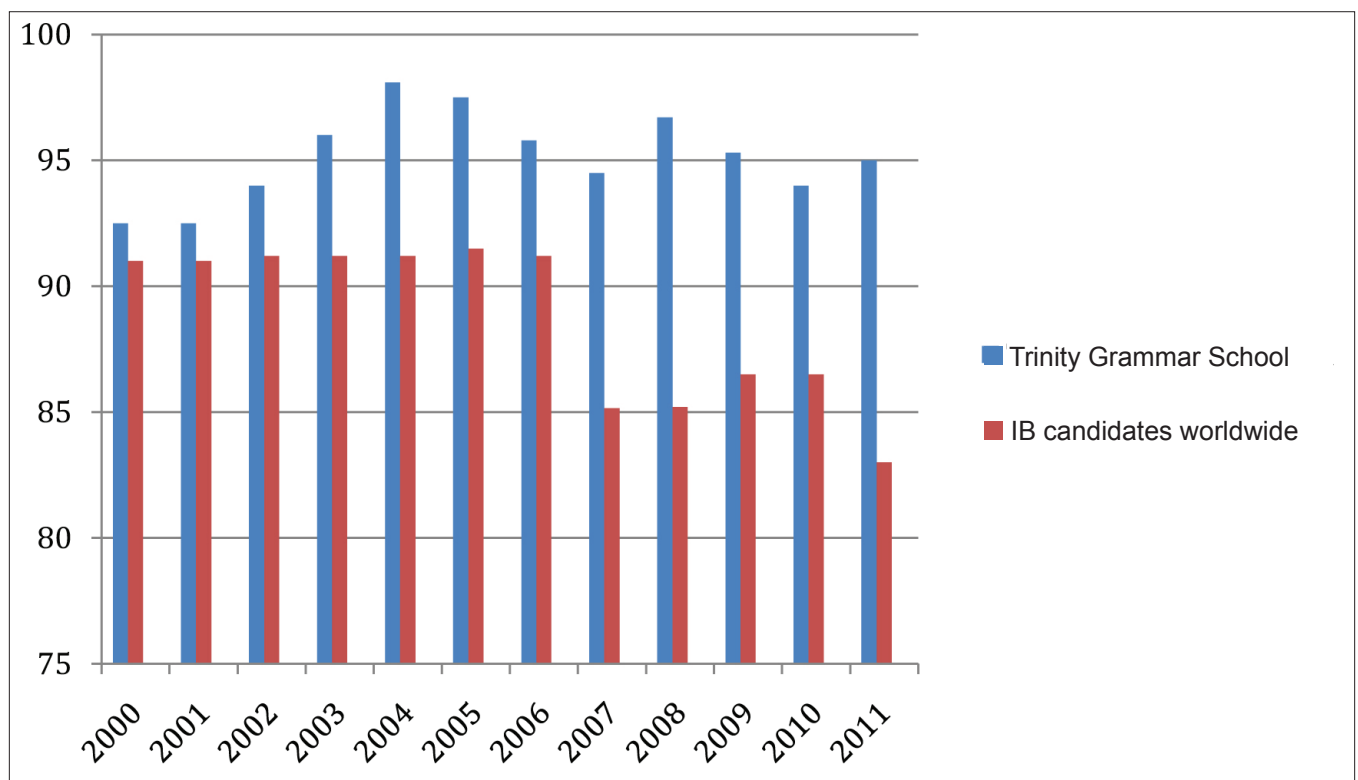
Consistency of application and hard work has produced a most gratifying outcome for our 2011 IB Diploma graduates. Notwithstanding a further recent recalibration of conversion data for IB Diploma results, which has made the IB “tougher” in terms of ATAR outcomes, our graduates achieved the following outstanding results for 2011:

Average IB points for Trinity Diplomates was 36.3 (which equates to an ATAR of 95.00). The World IB points average was 30.2.

- 17 (34%) received an ATAR equivalent of 98+
- 27 (53%) received an ATAR equivalent of 95+
- 36 (69%) received an ATAR equivalent of 90+
- 43 (85%) received an ATAR equivalent of 85+

Our largest cohort of IB diploma students has indeed received remarkable results in their final examinations to cement the overall excellent academic performance of the Class of 2011.
