It is my great pleasure to inform you that, after an extensive search and interview process, the School Council has unanimously appointed Mr Tim Bowden as the next Head Master of Trinity Grammar School. He will commence in January 2018 and will be only the third appointment to the position of Head Master of the School since the Second World War.
