Engineering and your performance in relevant subjects may not be reflected in your ATAR. We are pleased to offer you the Faculty of Engineering Admissions Scheme (FEAS) to give you the opportunity to demonstrate your passion for engineering and performance in relevant subjects to support your ATAR.

FEAS is an alternative pathway for students who want to study at UNSW but don't meet the Guaranteed Entry Rank (GE). You should apply for the Faculty of Engineering Admissions Scheme if you're expecting an ATAR between 83.00 and 90.95 and want to study at UNSW. FEAS applies to most UNSW Engineering undergraduate programs, including our double degrees with a Guaranteed Entry Rank (GE) of 91.

Torrens University

College of Health and Medicine Important Information

Applications, assessments and offers work differently for some Health and Medicine courses:

Medicine

Applications for Medicine will open in August and close on 30 September. Offers will be based on ATAR/UCAT and made when ATARs are released later in the year.

Paramedicine

Students can apply to study Paramedicine from 31 May until 30 September. Their applications will not be assessed based on the SRP rubric. Instead, offers will be made when ATAR results are released

Nursing

Nursing applications will open on 31 May. "On-time" applications will close 30 September. This means that students will be considered for a first-round offer. Late applications will open from 30 September onwards.

Students applying to the Rozelle campus in Sydney will be assessed for entry based on the school's recommendation and any students who are not eligible for an early offer will be reassessed upon release of ATARs. Students applying to the Tasmanian campuses will not be assessed using the SRP rubric. Instead, offers will be made when ATAR results are released.

Health Science (Medical Radiation Science)

Applications will open from 31 May. They will not be assessed using the SRP rubric. For year 12s, offers will be made when their ATAR results are released around mid-December.

Exercise Science, Laboratory Medicine

Applications will open from 31 May. Offers fall under the SRP dates and assessed using rubric responses.

Study in the US

No Testing Required for 2021-22 US University Admissions

US university application requirements for current year 12 students changed due to the pandemic. For the second consecutive year, most US universities will not require students to submit an SAT or ACT test result as part of the application process. Although there are a few institutions for which this does not apply, this is a giant step in the world of admissions.

Universities are still able to gain a solid understanding of an applicant without the test scores due to the [holistic admission process](#). University admission teams will put further emphasis on the other required components of the application such as an applicant's courses and earned marks (transcripts) dating back to year nine. Admission teams may also review the letters of recommendation through a new lens, as they strive to learn more about the applicant as an individual. As in the past, the personal statement will continue to be the sole place an applicant can determine what they want to convey to the admission team. For this reason, perhaps more significant time and reflection is required in crafting the personal statement.

1. Complete Bond's direct online application, submitting results from your Semester 1 Year 12 report, as well as your Semester 1 and 2 Year 11 reports.
2. Bond University will assess your application and high school grades against the minimum entry requirements for Bond's undergraduate* and diploma programs.
3. If you meet the entry requirements, you receive an early offer that guarantees entry to Bond conditional on the completion of Year 12 and meeting any subject prerequisite requirements for your program.
4. When you successfully complete Year 12 and pass any prerequisite subjects, your offer becomes unconditional and you are officially a Bondy!

*Note: Bond's Medical Program is excluded from these revised entry requirements.
